FOREWORD

Dear Brethren and Sisters—

Another annual report comes to your hand. And it comes thus concisely printed, because of the labor of love of our church secretaries, Mr. J. C. George and Mr. G. H. Jones, to whom we owe a debt of gratitude for their continued faithfulness.

The Treasurers also, Mr. M. B. Jones and Mr. D. E. Davies, deserve our warmest commendation for their loyal service as custodians of our church funds.

Nor are we forgetful of the secretaries and treasurers of the auxiliary societies of Salem and Zion. To these friends we extend our cordial appreciation. And what is more, we assure them all of Heaven's appreciation: "For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labor of love, which ye have shewed toward His name." Hebrews 6:10.

Calling to remembrance God's goodness to us as a people during the past year, it is most fitting for us to raise our Ebenezer and say: "Hitherto hath the Lord helped us."

Though we suffered a loss in the removal by death of some of our saintliest members; still, to counteract that loss, we were privileged to receive twenty-six of the children of the church, after due instruction, into full communion—twenty three in Salem and three in Zion. Thus—

Whatsoever success has attended our efforts in the past, we must remember that we dare not rest on our laurels, but, rather, "press on—PRESS ON—into perfection."

For one thing, in the immediate future, we have our contribution to make to the Inter-church World Movement—that union of all Protestant communions in our country, which aims "to attempt great things for God" in the way of world evangelization, and which logically "expects great things from God." If we would hope to draw upon the resources of God, we must undertake the program of God, and that program includes the evangelization of the world.

In Nehemiah's time, a great work for God was accomplished, because "the people had a mind—a heart—to work." And greater things can yet be fulfilled by us, if we but "have a heart to work."
