## FOREWORD

Dear Brethren and Sisters:—

We have come to the end of another church year, and we are glad to present to you these reports of the churches. It is unnecessary for us to enter into any detailed consideration of the Reports, we will let them speak for themselves.

The Reports of necessity contain a backward look. But looking back is not the chief characteristic of a Christian. "No man, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God." We are not willing to be satisfied with any accomplishment, but we are anxious to take forward steps in all the fields of our endeavor. We are glad to be able to report that we meet all the demands made upon our churches. This coming year we are asked to contribute 10% more towards the benevolences of the Church than last year, and we believe that we will meet it.

But may we remember that financial progress is not the only thing necessary. It is the means to reach the goal, and the goal is more important than the means. The purpose of the existence of the church is found in a few pregnant sayings of the Master. May we take this opportunity to call each other's attention to these sayings: "Ye are the salt of the earth;" "Ye are the light of the world." Christ uses the most common things of life to explain the purpose of the church. We know that these things must be replenished in our homes if they are to continue in their usefulness, and they must be used if they are not to become a burden. This is equally true in the spiritual realm; we need a new supply continually. In present conditions there are two channels along which these supplies may come to us.

1. The home. We are often reminded that religion in the home is in danger. We need to have it re-established, and re-established on a firmer basis than ever. We do not advocate an elaborate family worship. Christianity as we understand it is characterised by simplicity, and family worship ought to be simple if it is to be effective. It ought to be just enough to assure us that the channel between us and heaven is open. If that is kept open we can draw upon the full supply in any emergency.

2. The church in all its branches; the public services, the Sunday School, the Young People's Societies, and the Prayer Meetings. This is the channel of information and inspiration. The man who lives entirely alone is poorly informed, and less inspired. The church through its services is the place to be informed and inspired in the noblest things.

There is, however, the other side to our lives. When God called Abraham He said unto him; "I will bless thee . . . and be thou a blessing. This is the function of the church. God does not pour His gifts upon us for us to hold them, but for us to use them; we are to help those who need help," Matt. xxv, 31-45.

We put these Reports in your hands praying that what we have accomplished will inspire us for nobler and greater things.
