## FOREWORD

Dear brothers and sisters—

We are pleased to present to you our Annual Report for the year 1928-1929. It contains many things that are encouraging.

We have been able to reach the financial goal that we accepted for ourselves both in our home work and in our benevolences. We might make a suggestion. At the end of the year the books are clear, but at periods during the year those in charge of the finance of the churches find themselves in narrow straits. We take this opportunity to remind each other of the advisability of regular contributions toward the work of the church. The church should be an example to all in meeting its financial obligations punctually. It is unfortunate that some times business men have to wait for their money when they need that money in their business.

The same applies to the Benevolences. It might be news to some that our Boards pay annually thousands of dollars in interest because the money does not come to hand before the last weeks of the church year. We make a strong appeal for regular contributions throughout the year. Let us make it our goal to be regular in this grace as well as in others. We will find the Apostolic injunction helpful if we practice it: "Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay in store as God hath prospered him."

The world is passing through a great change. We read of OUR CHANGING CIVILIZATION and the world thinks seriously upon this problem. At such a time we need to be on our guard lest we loose things of abiding value. It is easier to hold things of value while we possess them than to regain them if we loose them. And it is very easy to loose them. Negligence alone is enough to loose the most valuable treasures, but it demands persistence, vigilance, and suffering to repossess the least thing once it is lost. "Hold fast that which is good."

We can bear witness to the splendid work that is being done to fit the future generation for life. The work done in the Sunday Schools is well planned and it will bear fruit in the years to come. This is true of all the Departments of the Sunday Schools, but we call special attention to the patience, care, and thought devoted by the teachers of the younger generation in both Sunday Schools, and to the splendid work done in the Junior Society at Salem by the Superintendent and her assistants.

The whole work of the church may be summed up in two words, IMPRESSION and EXPRESSION. The Sunday services are services to impress the truths upon our minds. This is the object of public worship and the Sunday School. Then we have the week night service and the Christian Endeavor for the purpose of expression. We need both for a complete Christian character.
