We stand on the threshold of seeing much being accomplished in the life of our churches. New programs and new concerns for building up the physical structures and improve our own worship center with the purchase of a new organ and to worship in a newly decorated sanctuary ... ought to stimulate our faith to set us on the way in a new concern for the priorities of faith, witnessing and reaching out into the community for the cause of Christ and his kingdom. This is a year when exciting things are happening in the area of Evangelism. The **PRIORITIES** that **YOU** establish in **YOUR** life will determine what our church will do in the coming year.
