A Word from the Pastor

Dear Friends,

There is much to celebrate in the work God has done among us in this past year, and I look forward with anticipation to the new things God has begun in our midst for this coming year.

We welcomed 4 new members this year, and restored an inactive member to the roll. It was a special cause for celebration when we baptized three adults on Easter Sunday. We have a class of 10 young people who are busily preparing for confirmation at Pentecost.

We hosted Deb Smelser, a Commissioned Lay Pastor Intern this past year, and were blessed to have her here among us. We sought to enrich our spiritual lives as she led a Spiritual Disciplines video series this past fall.

The exterior renovations were completed this year, and when they were done, we had the money to pay the full \$125,000. Pledges and gifts continued to come in for the Now It's Our Turn campaign, and we hope to begin work on the stained glass windows soon. The cost of the renovations is higher than we originally anticipated, but we are confident that the congregation will rise to the challenge. We already have received gifts and pledges of over \$150,000.

The Community Care Team began hosting monthly senior luncheons at the Lions Club, and they have been welcomed by the participants. We also applied for and received a grant of \$500 from the denomination to cover equipment and publicity costs. Plans are being made for more additional community building activities in the coming year.

I am especially excited about the opportunities that lie ahead of us in this coming year. At the session retreat, we established two new committees that will be working on special projects in this coming year. One will be seeking to discern God's will for our future, and develop a vision statement with corresponding goals. This committee will be seeking your input, and it is important that everyone participate so that we can together discern God's call for Salem Church and follow it into the future. The second will be addressing stewardship issues as we seek to respond faithfully to God's call to us as a congregation.
